

Overview of **my work** related to the Trans Mountain Expansion

- **Voted against the Opposition Motion in the House of Commons that sought to affirm the social license of the TMX pipeline**
- Participated in 6 Ministerial panel hearings and presented an 18-page report on behalf of our community
- Produced a comprehensive economic analysis of the project and potential alternatives for every Member of Parliament
- Continued to work with Tsleil-Waututh, Squamish, and Musqueam peoples in order to fully understand their concerns and work collaboratively on this project as well as many others
- Chair of the TMX sub-caucus working group
- Participated in the Detailed Route Hearings
- Attended hearings of the National Energy Board
- Read and analysed all relevant documents totalling thousands of pages
- Regularly meet with Ministers to ensure all 157 conditions are met, including issues with snow netting being used to discourage salmon spawning
- Regularly update the Prime Minister and all Members of Parliament on TMX
- Knocked on over 100,000 doors in our community so that I can personally hear your concerns and be confident taking our collective voice to Ottawa
- Hosted numerous town halls, coffee meetings, and countless other meetings with experts, environmentalists, stakeholders, labour leaders, families, and concerned citizens in order to hear the spectrum of opinions so I can be the best possible voice for our community
- Currently working on an updated, comprehensive report of my work on TMX in our community since the approval of the project
