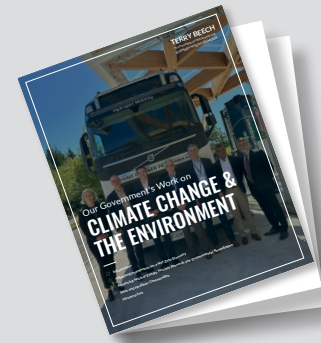

CANADA'S CLIMATE PLAN IS WORKING

For the first time in history, Canada has reduced emissions while growing the economy. Emissions are now 7.1% below 2005 levels, a clear sign that our climate efforts are making a difference. However, due to provincial changes in carbon pricing, British Columbians aren't seeing the same benefits as other provinces. Outside of BC, 600,000 small businesses have received \$2.5 billion in rebates under the federal program and the average family gets approximately \$1000 a year in rebate payments. Let's work together to make BC's carbon price revenue-neutral again so businesses and families can benefit from our efforts to fight climate change here at home.

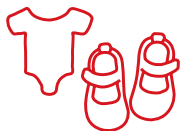

TAX CUTS FOR WORKING CANADIANS

BIG SAVINGS FOR FAMILIES AND WORKERS

This holiday season, we're helping Canadians with a GST holiday from December to February. Families will see a 5% discount on groceries, children's clothing, diapers, toys, and takeout meals from local restaurants. We have also proposed a tax cut for middle-class workers who will receive a \$250 rebate. Together, these measures represent a \$6.3 billion tax cut, directly benefiting working Canadians, over one million seniors, and 62% of Canadians with disabilities who go to work everyday.

These measures are possible because Canada's economy is stable and strong. With inflation and interest rates dropping faster than in any comparable country, we remain a global leader in fiscal responsibility. The Independent Parliamentary Budget Officer recently confirmed that Canada has \$46 billion of flexibility within its fiscal framework, ensuring that we can support Canadians while continuing to grow our economy.

TERRY'S UPDATE ON PASSPORTS

During the postal strike, Service Canada has worked hard to change how we deliver passports to Canadians. We have continued processing passports and have 215,000 of them sitting in processing centers in BC (new!), Ontario and Quebec. Normally we order them by transaction date. We are re-sorting them by postal code and using our limited Purolator capacity to deliver them to 60 pickup sites across Canada. This has meant that Canadians have been able to get their Passports even during the strike. I've also been working hard to deliver online passport renewals so that you never have to wait in line for a passport again. More news on that coming in early 2025.

WE HAVE BUMPER STICKERS

Our grocery bags were a huge success, and now we're trying something new. We've produced 100 bumper stickers with a restick coating that can easily be removed from a window or bumper. If you'd like to help us spread the word, we'd be happy to send you one! It's often intimidating for individuals to reach out to their MP office to access services or to share ideas. We want everyone to know that our office is open and ready to serve you and your family.
