

FROM THE DESK OF TERRY BEECH

Dear Friends and Neighbours,

On January 6th, 2024, I was on the tarmac at YVR watching our Prime Minister step down from office after 17 years of public service. I was on my way to Ottawa to do work regarding the Ministry of Citizens' Services and to attend a caucus meeting later that week. The following day, I had an opportunity to sit down with the Prime Minister to thank him one-on-one for his significant contribution to Canada.

In ten short years, the Prime Minister has made significant and impactful contributions to our nation. He has more than doubled our investment in our military forces and has committed to tripling it by the time we reach our 2% NATO contribution in 2032. He led us through a global pandemic, keeping us healthier and in better economic shape than nearly any other Nation. He raised hundreds of thousands of children and seniors out of poverty by lowering the pension eligibility from 67 to 65, increasing pension benefits through a historic deal with all Premiers and implementing the Canada Child Care Benefit and \$10/day Childcare. While the entire world has faced hardship with global inflation, these programs were lifelines to help make life more affordable.

Canada is a global leader in fighting climate change and is in a position to reap the long-term economic rewards of that investment. We have made meaningful progress on Indigenous reconciliation and have delivered a \$200B health accord, dental care, and pharmacare.

Any of these achievements would have been a significant legacy for a sitting Prime Minister, but to do all of this while keeping our Deficit and Debt/GDP ratios as the lowest in the G7 is quite remarkable. Our economy is rated triple-A. Our interest expense on debt is close to 1%, while it is 5% in the United States and was 6% in Canada in the 1990s.

On behalf of our community and future generations, including my own daughters, I want to take this opportunity to say thank you. Looking ahead, we have an exciting opportunity to build the future Canada that we all want. I recently put a poll into the field asking for your opinion on who our next Prime Minister should be, and I will take this opportunity to invite you to reach out to me personally or through our constituency office.

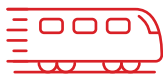
