Dear Friends and Neighbours,

Welcome everyone, to the 45th Parliament and a new era for Canada led by Prime Minister Mark Carney. Thank you to everyone in our community for trusting me to represent our shared interests for a fourth term. This is the strongest mandate we've ever received, and I am committed to working hard every day to ensure that our voices are heard in Ottawa. For the 41% of individuals who voted for someone else, I'll remind you that party politics is reserved for elections only. Once you're elected, you have a responsibility to represent all voices in our community, and I will work hard to serve you and earn your trust as well. I will continue to advocate for our shared priorities, to make life more affordable, and to build a healthier, fairer, and more sustainable future for everyone in North Vancouver and Burnaby.

As we begin this new parliamentary session, I want to take a moment to reintroduce you to our community office and the team that supports our work. Our constituency office is here to help Burnaby North-Seymour residents access federal programs and services, navigate government systems, and resolve casework issues with care and urgency. Whether you are looking for assistance with pensions, immigration, Employment Insurance, the Canada Child Benefit, or other federal matters, our team is ready to help. Affordability & Tax Relief

Affordability continues to be one of the top concerns I hear from families and individuals across our community. That is why our first legislation of the new Parliament is to deliver tax relief for nearly 22 million Canadians. As recently announced, the federal government is reducing the lowest personal income tax rate from 15% to 14%, effective July 1, 2025. This change will result in real savings for working Canadians, with two-income households seeing up to \$840 in tax relief annually by 2026. Over the next five years, this measure will return more than \$27 billion to Canadians, with the majority of the benefit going to those earning under \$114,750 annually. Nearly half of the total tax savings will go to those earning less than \$57,375.

Dental Care

At the same time, we are continuing to strengthen public health care. The Canadian Dental Care Plan has made a significant difference in its first year. Over 3.4 million Canadians have been approved to join the program, and over 1.7 million have already received care. Access to affordable dental coverage is a major step forward in improving health outcomes and reducing barriers to care nationwide.

Since May, eligible Canadians between 18 and 64 can apply for the Canadian Dental Care Plan. To qualify, applicants must not have access to dental insurance, have filed their 2024 tax return, have an adjusted family net income below \$90,000, and be a Canadian resident.

PROTECTING OUR BORDERS AND COMMUNITIES

Canadians expect their government to keep communities safe. That's why our government has introduced the Strong Borders Act – a comprehensive new law to enhance public safety and disrupt transnational crime.

THIS NEW LEGISLATION WILL



Combat Organized Crime & Drug Smuggling: Give law enforcement and border agents stronger tools to stop the flow of illegal fentanyl, weapons, and stolen vehicles.



Expand Border Security: Improve inspection authority at ports of entry and empower the RCMP and CBSA with new capabilities.



Modernize Immigration & Asylum Systems: Improve processing times, protect the integrity of our system, and allow for quicker response to surges in claims.



Disrupt Illicit Financing: Strengthen anti-money laundering enforcement and restrict suspicious cash transactions to prevent criminal activity.



Support Law Enforcement Investigations: Ensure service providers comply with lawful data requests and allow police to investigate suspicious mail.

We are also investing over \$1.3 billion in Canada's Border Plan to enhance intelligence, hire more RCMP and CBSA officers, and expand coast guard security patrols. This means better protection for our communities, including right here in Burnaby and North Vancouver.

As your MP, I remain committed to advocating for a safer, fairer, and more secure Canada – one where our kids can grow up without fear and where law enforcement has the tools they need to succeed.

ELIMINATING THE GST FOR FIRST-TIME HOME BUYERS



Canada is in a housing crisis – demand has gone up, supply has not kept pace, and prices are too high. The new government of Canada is taking immediate action to address this crisis.

Prime Minister Carney announced that the Government of Canada will eliminate the Goods and Services Tax (GST) for first-time homebuyers on homes at or under \$1 million. This tax cut will save Canadians up to \$50,000, allowing more young people and families to enter the housing market and realize the dream of homeownership.

By eliminating the GST, Canadians will face lower upfront housing costs and keep more money in their pocket. Eliminating the GST will also have a dynamic effect on increasing supply – spurring the construction of new homes across the country.

Our government is focused on lowering costs and will continue to present serious solutions to ensure our families have the tools they need to get ahead. This is one more step to confront the housing crisis head-on and build the strongest economy in the G7.

Ravi and I are the proud parents of two daughters, Solar (4) and Nova (6), who continue to be my greatest motivation to help build a better future for Canada. I want the world they grow up in to be fair, affordable, clean, and safe. The work we do in Parliament during this mandate will shape the path ahead—not just for our children, but for generations to come.

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
