

## FROM THE DESK OF TERRY BEECH

Dear Friends and Neighbours,

It has been nearly a year since our community entrusted me to represent you in this new Parliament. Today, I am writing to give you an update on how we are standing up for Canada during a time of global change, and how that work is delivering results right here in Burnaby and North Vancouver.

### Navigating a Global Shift

We are living through a moment of profound transformation. As Prime Minister Carney recently said, the world is facing a "rupture"—a generational shift in the global economy that is reshaping trade and supply chains. We see the impact of this every day, from the cost of goods at the grocery store to the uncertainty caused by rising global tariffs.

In the face of these challenges, our government is acting decisively. We are not just waiting for the dust to settle; we are building a unified economy that protects Canadian workers and businesses. We are investing in the strategic industries of tomorrow—sectors that are thriving right here in our riding, from the clean-tech innovations at Simon Fraser University to global leaders like STEMCELL Technologies and Arc'teryx.

### Fiscal Responsibility

We are doing this while keeping our fiscal house in order. Canada remains one of the world's most trusted economies. We have the lowest net debt-to-GDP ratio in the G7 and we are one of only two G7 countries to hold a AAA credit rating. This isn't just a statistic; it is a signal of confidence that keeps our borrowing costs low and protects the social programs we all rely on.

### A Victory for Compassion: Evan's Law

While managing the economy is vital, my most important job is being your voice in Ottawa. I am incredibly proud to share that on February 4th, my private member's bill, **Bill C-222 (Evan's Law)**, passed its Second Reading in the House of Commons unanimously.

## Highlights from the First Year

### Expanded Trade and Diplomatic Relationships

- Secured visa-free travel to China for Canadians, strengthening tourism, business mobility, education exchanges, and cultural ties.
- Concluded a landmark Canada–China economic arrangement that lowers Chinese tariffs on key Canadian exports and establishes a managed corridor for Chinese electric vehicles under a capped 6.1% tariff which unlocks billions in export potential.
- Advanced diversification of trade relationships, pursuing a dozen new agreements across four continents.
- Deepened engagement with India, ASEAN nations, and Mercosur to open new economic corridors.
- Strengthened strategic partnerships with Europe, including a defence and security accord giving Canadian companies access to the EU's €1.25-trillion ReArm Europe program.
- Reduced Canada's reliance on the United States by expanding global export markets and diplomatic links.

### Cutting Taxes and Supporting Canadians

- Implemented a new middle-class tax cut, saving a typical two-income family up to \$840 per year.
- Launched automatic tax filing, simplifying access to benefits and improving tax delivery for Canadians.
- Introduced the Canada Groceries and Essentials Benefit, increasing the former GST Credit by 25% for five years starting July 2026 and issuing a one-time 50% top-up this year. Saving up to \$1,890 this year and \$1,400 annually for four years for a family of four.
- Invested \$500 million to stabilize supply chains and reduce cost pass-through to consumers.
- Introduced immediate expensing for greenhouse buildings to accelerate domestic food production and improve long-term affordability.

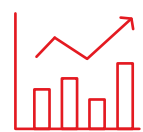
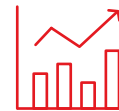


### Nation Building Projects in B.C.

- Advanced LNG Canada Phase 2 in Kitimat to support jobs and major energy development.
- Expanded the Red Chris Mine in northwest B.C., boosting employment and strengthening the minerals sector.
- Developed the North Coast Transmission Line, supporting clean power access and community growth.
- Progressed Ksi Lisims LNG on Pearse Island, advancing clean energy and Indigenous-led economic development.

### Fiscal Modernization and Government Transformation

- Introduced a new capital budgeting framework that separates day-to-day operating costs from long-term economic investments, modernizing Canada's fiscal architecture.
- Shifted the federal budget cycle to the fall, improving planning for provinces, territories, municipalities, builders, and investors by aligning decisions with the construction season.
- Established a new Office of Digital Transformation to lead the adoption of AI and modern technologies across government.
- Launched made-in-Canada sovereign AI tools for the public service, improving efficiency while supporting Canadian tech innovators.
- Redirected federal spending toward nation-building infrastructure, clean energy, innovation, and productivity, with less allocated to routine operating costs.
- Ensured social benefits remain protected through a more disciplined, long-term approach to public spending.
- Rightsized government to realign resources toward generational investments that strengthen Canada's future.
